

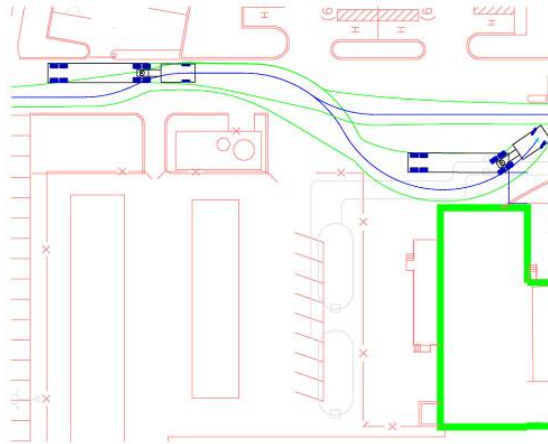
Beaumont West Powerhouse Generator

Spalding DeDecker Associates, Inc. (SDA) provided a preliminary study of the best possible location for a temporary generator to be delivered to Beaumont Hospital in the event of an emergency situation.

In the event that Southeast Michigan experiences another blackout, Beaumont Hospital was prepared with back-up power for their most critical instruments but desired redundancy in these circumstances for their less critical instruments as well.

The study included an analysis of the route that the semi-truck will have to take to deliver the generator, the maneuvering that the truck will have to take to place the generator in its desired location, and an itemization of what existing site features will be impacted by the route.
