Surveying consultant on the project. The site engineering work included paving and grading design, stormwater management, sanitary sewer, and watermain design.

SDA incorporated various stormwater management measures, including rain gardens and bioretention zones, into the site, and the project is LEED Certified.

SDA's services also included onsite construction observation.
