

15 Mile Road Watermain Replacement

Clinton Township, Michigan



The watermain on 15 Mile Road had to be relocated in advance of the Road Commission of Macomb County's (RCMC) 15 Mile Road Widening Project. The existing approximately 1.25 miles of 12" watermain was located within the influence of the new road section and had to be moved.

Spalding DeDecker Associates, Inc. (SDA) was responsible for the design and contract administration of the relocation of the

watermain.

SPECIAL FEATURES

SDA worked with the Township and RCMC officials to design, bid, and install the relocated watermain in advance of the road project.

The preparation and acquisition of easements were necessary to construct the relocated watermain. RCMC was in the process of acquiring rights-of-way but would not have received them with enough lead-time to relocate the watermain. SDA employees went door-to-door to help acquire the easements for the Township.



SDA established and met the aggressive schedule. The project was out for bid in the Spring of 2002 before the season's construction projects were bid. This allowed the Township to receive an economical and time-committed bid from contractors.
